

# CSC MEMBERSHIP PASSPORT

## GOLD

Skaters (under 18) join with a parent/guardian and any additional family members as necessary. This is a combined membership.

## WHITE

Skaters are in their first year with CSC- they have not previously belonged to a figure skating club. This is an introductory individual membership, held for one year.

## RED

An individual membership for Senior skaters (over 18), non-skating Seniors, associate members, collegiate members, honorary and non-skating CSC board members.

## BLACK

CSC offers a professional membership for the following categories: skating coach (must actively teach at a CSC designated facility) or have United States Figure Skating appointment of judge, accountant, announcer, music player or technical specialist.

Choosing the right membership category is simple. Our color passport puts you in the right direction from the start. Follow the list below for another fun-filled year in figure skating!

1. **Know your membership color - Gold, White, Red or Black.** Each membership color has its own membership form unique to the needs of the membership type. **(see column 1, page 1)**
2. **Know your summer plan -** Have your renewal completed by June 30, 2020 for all summer competitions.
3. **Read the waivers and agreement - go online to our membership page.** Waivers and agreements are a normal part of every club's membership process. Save time by reading them ahead. There are a few changes to the waivers/agreements this year.
4. **Go to our online page for membership from the CSC website.** Click the correct membership color and complete the online form with payment.
5. **Go to our online Record Your Volunteer hours page -** add a bookmark. Be sure to record your hours each time you volunteer for the club. Hours will be verified by the appropriate committee chair.
6. **Within two weeks of joining or renewing your membership, you will receive a letter from our membership chair,** once again confirming your membership and all member benefits.
7. **Receive our CSC member only periodic email blasts.** Be sure to update your email if it changes to continue this service (contact Jessica Williams at [figureskate24\\_7@sbcglobal.net](mailto:figureskate24_7@sbcglobal.net) to update your email address).
8. **Keep your membership in good standing.** Your membership is paid and current, volunteer hours are submitted regularly and you are following the CSC/USFS Code of Conduct.
